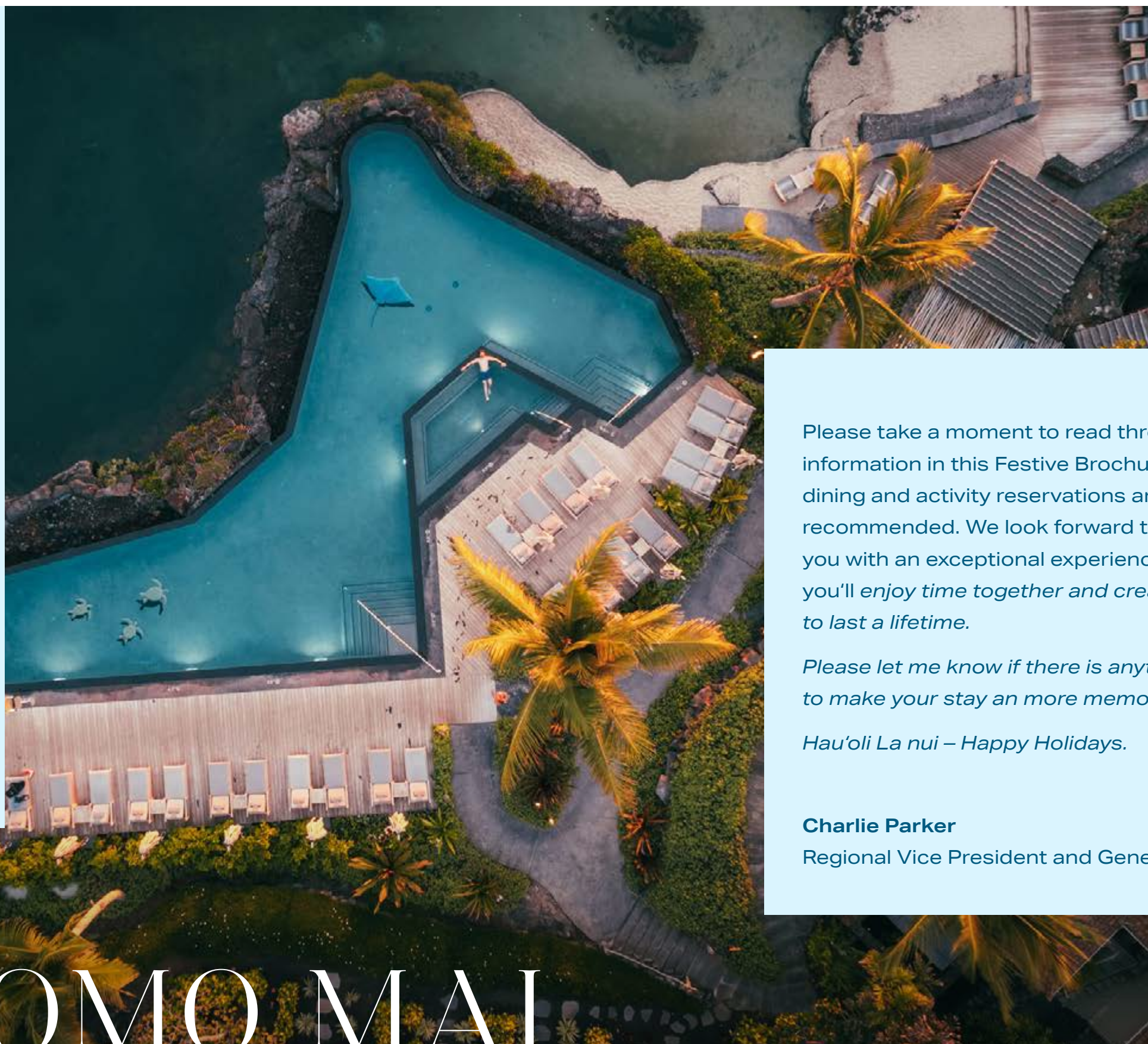


# ALOHA,

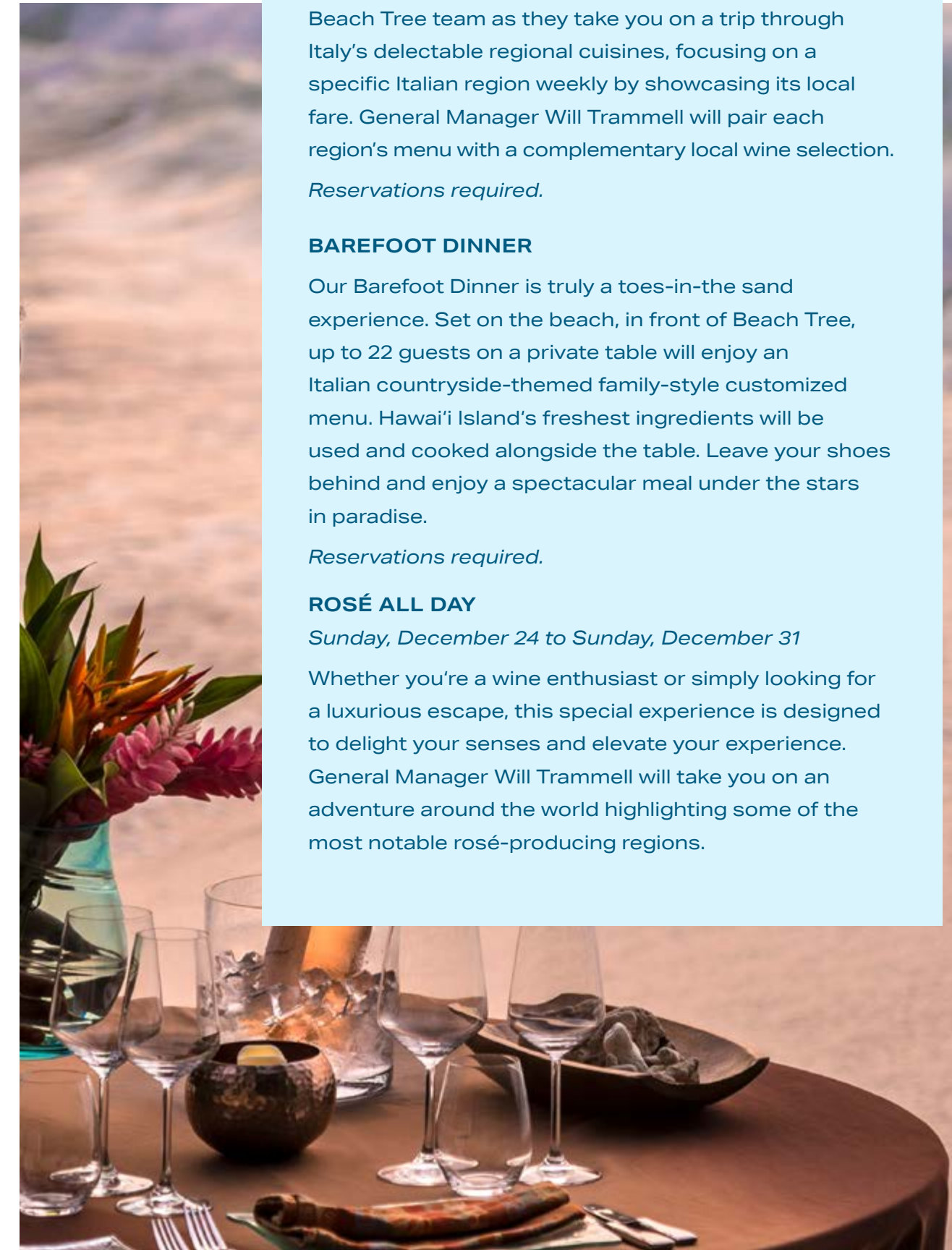

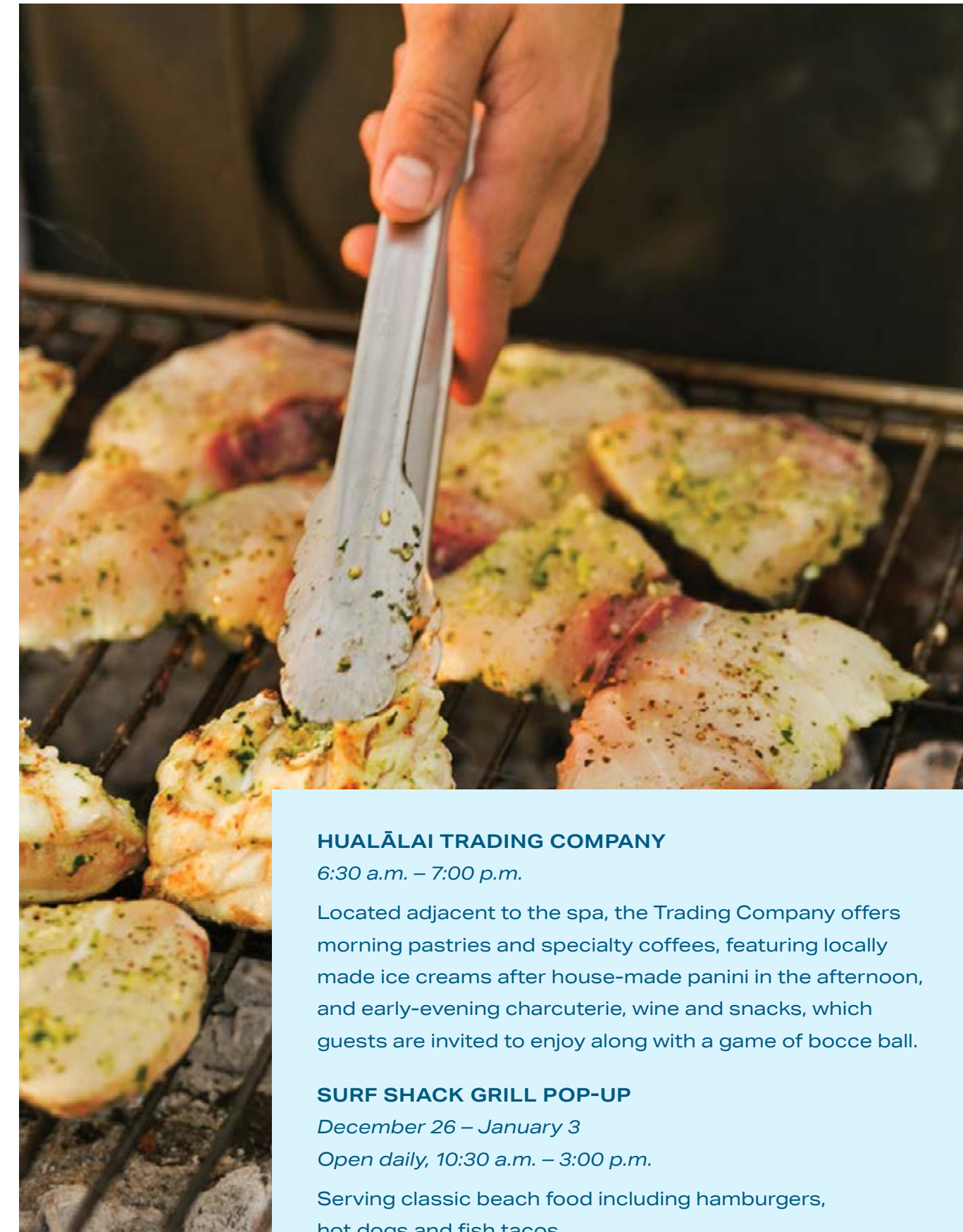

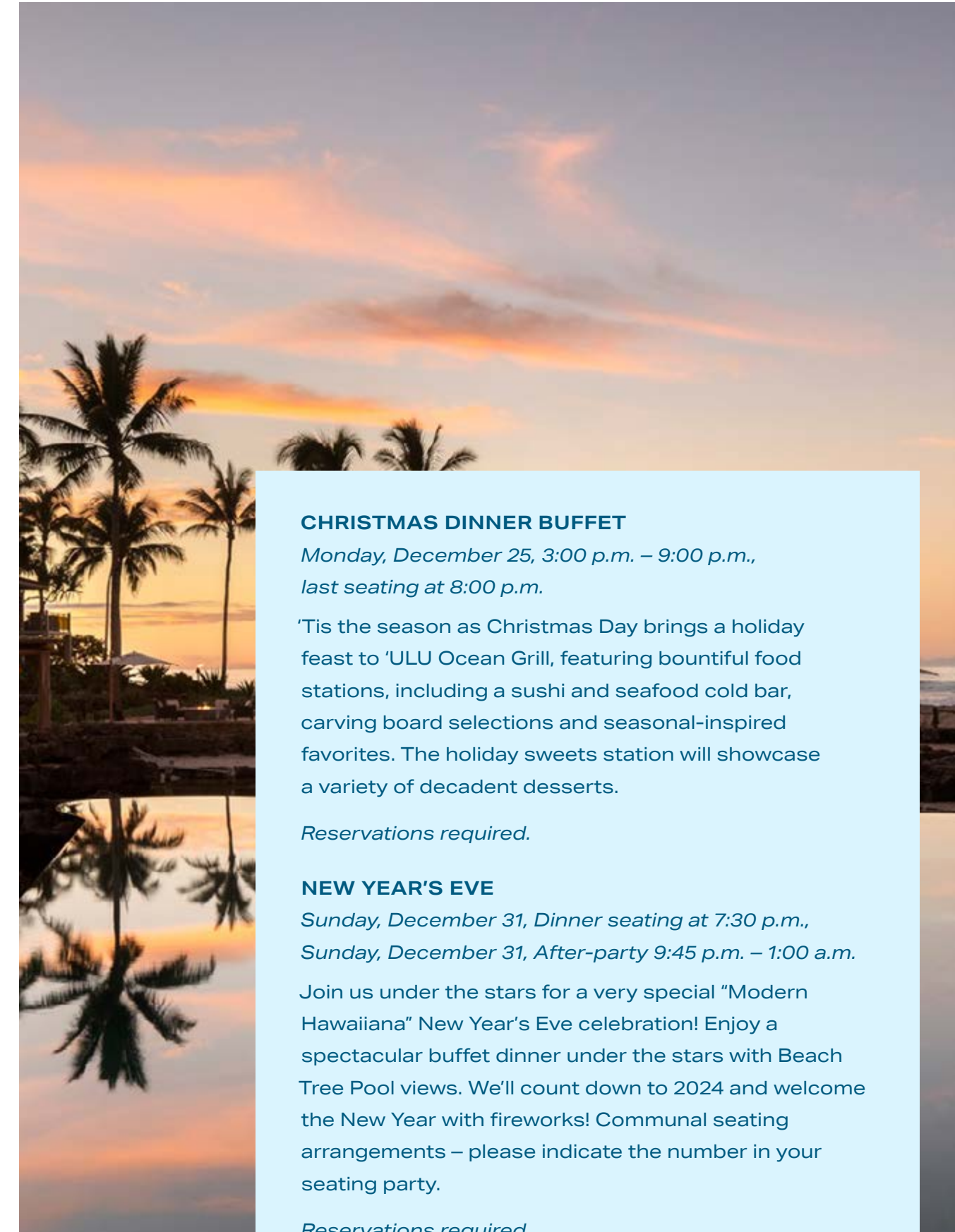

Due to high demand for reservations during this period, please make reservations in advance of your arrival. Please be aware that if no reservations are made prior to your arrival, reservation times will be limited. Reservations are designated as the two-hour period following the time of the reservation. Guests taking longer at their table may be relocated to the lounge. Specialty dining, such as the Wine Classes, Cooking Classes, Barefoot Table and 'Ohana-Style dining have limited availability.

**LARGE PARTIES**

Due to space considerations, we will not be able to honor all requests for large tables. Parties larger than 8 guests may be seated at separate tables. Please note, all reservations will be released after 15 minutes of the reserved time if the entire confirmed party does not show, and a no-show/cancellation fee will apply. For families dining together, please provide the names of all family members to avoid double bookings.

**FOOD & WINE POLICY**

Please ask our Concierge for our food policies and restrictions. We offer an award-winning wine list that evolves often, based on current trends and guest preferences.

*A corkage fee of \$75 per bottle applies.*

**CANCELLATION & NO-SHOW POLICY**

For any reservations that are cancelled within four (4) hours of the reservation time or if the party does not show for their reservation, a \$35 per person fee will apply. All reservations will be released after 15 minutes of reserved time if the party does not arrive.

*The following events will be subject to a cancellation fee of 100% of the total reservation as a no-show fee or if cancelled within 48 hours: Barefoot Dinners, Cooking Class, Luau, Promontory Wine Dinner, Christmas Dinner and New Year's Eve Dinner.*

**DINNER UNDER THE STARS CANCELLATION POLICY**

Dinners will incur a \$500 cancellation fee if cancelled within five days of the dinner's scheduled start time. Dinners will incur a full cancellation fee (full base cost of dinner) if cancelled within 48 hours of dinner's scheduled start time. Reservations are accepted within 45 days of your desired date, and no later than 72 hours in advance.

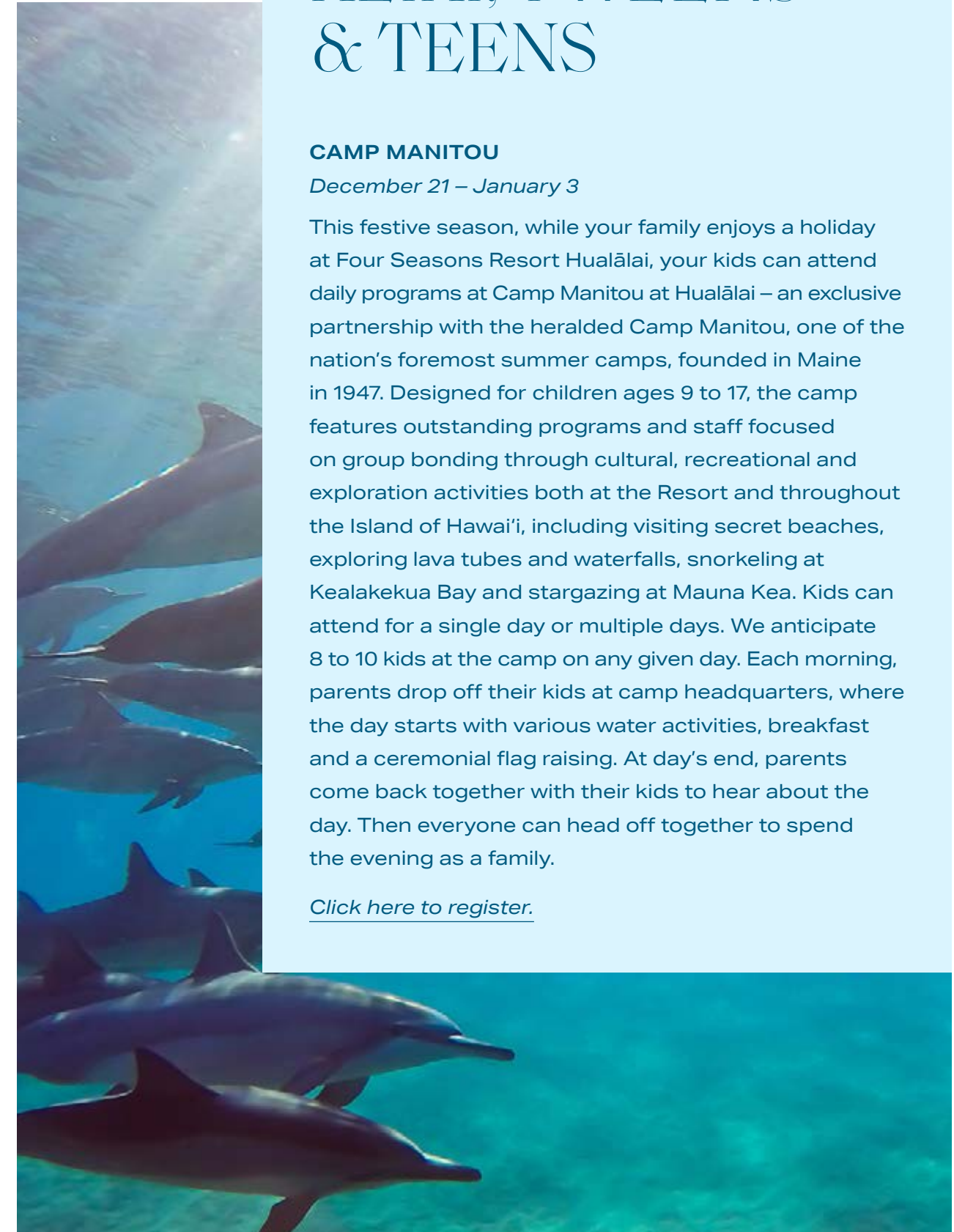

### CAMP MANITOU

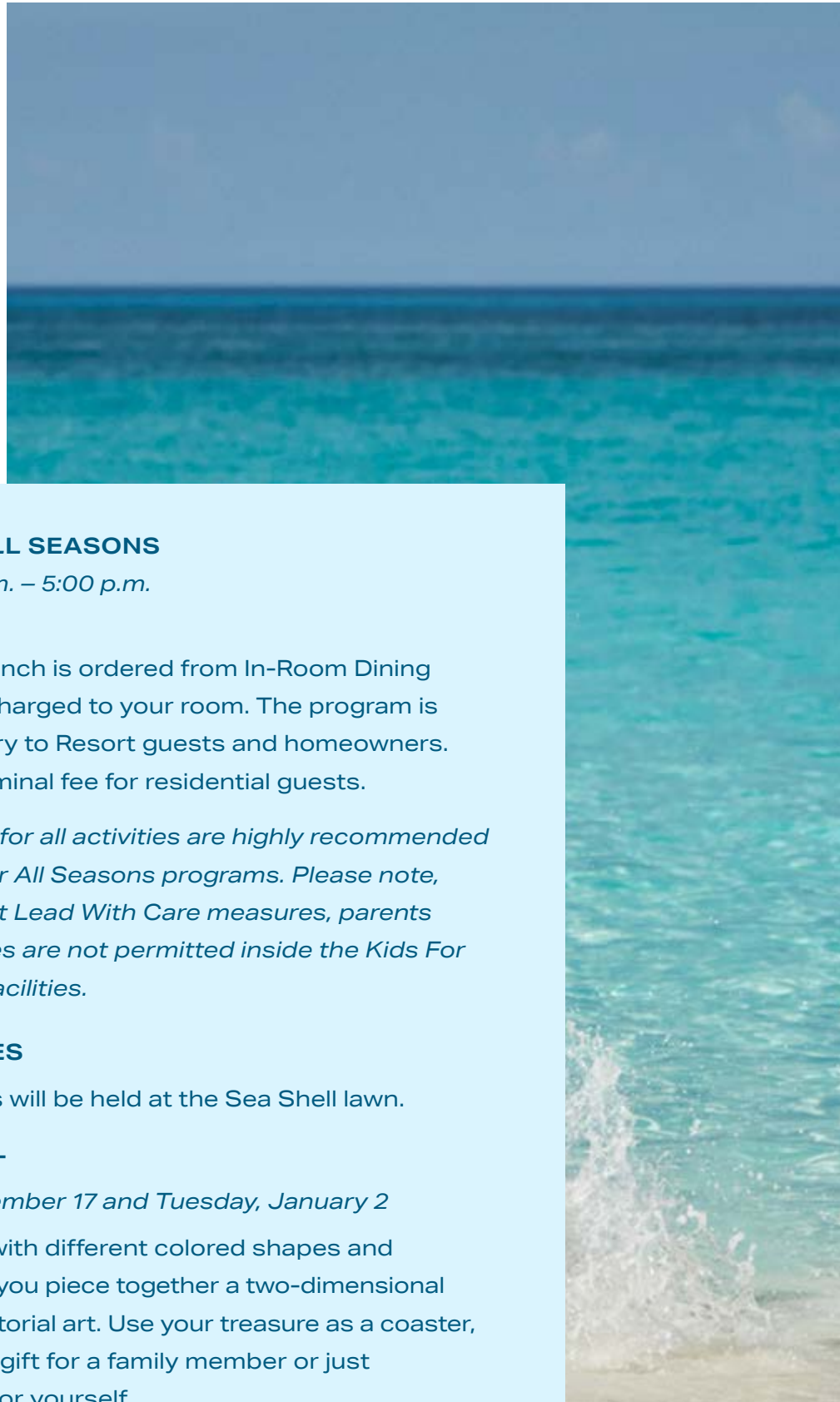

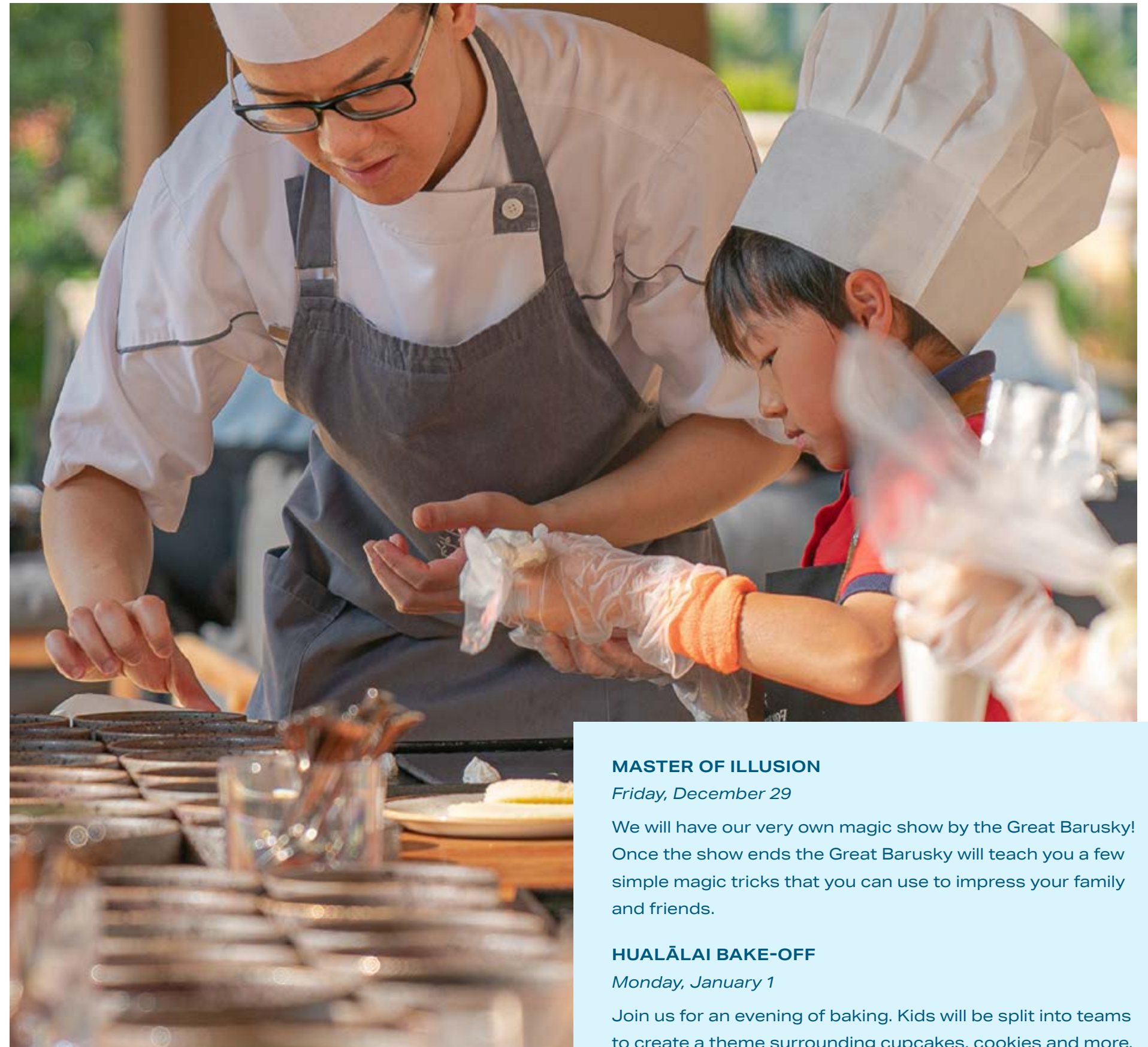

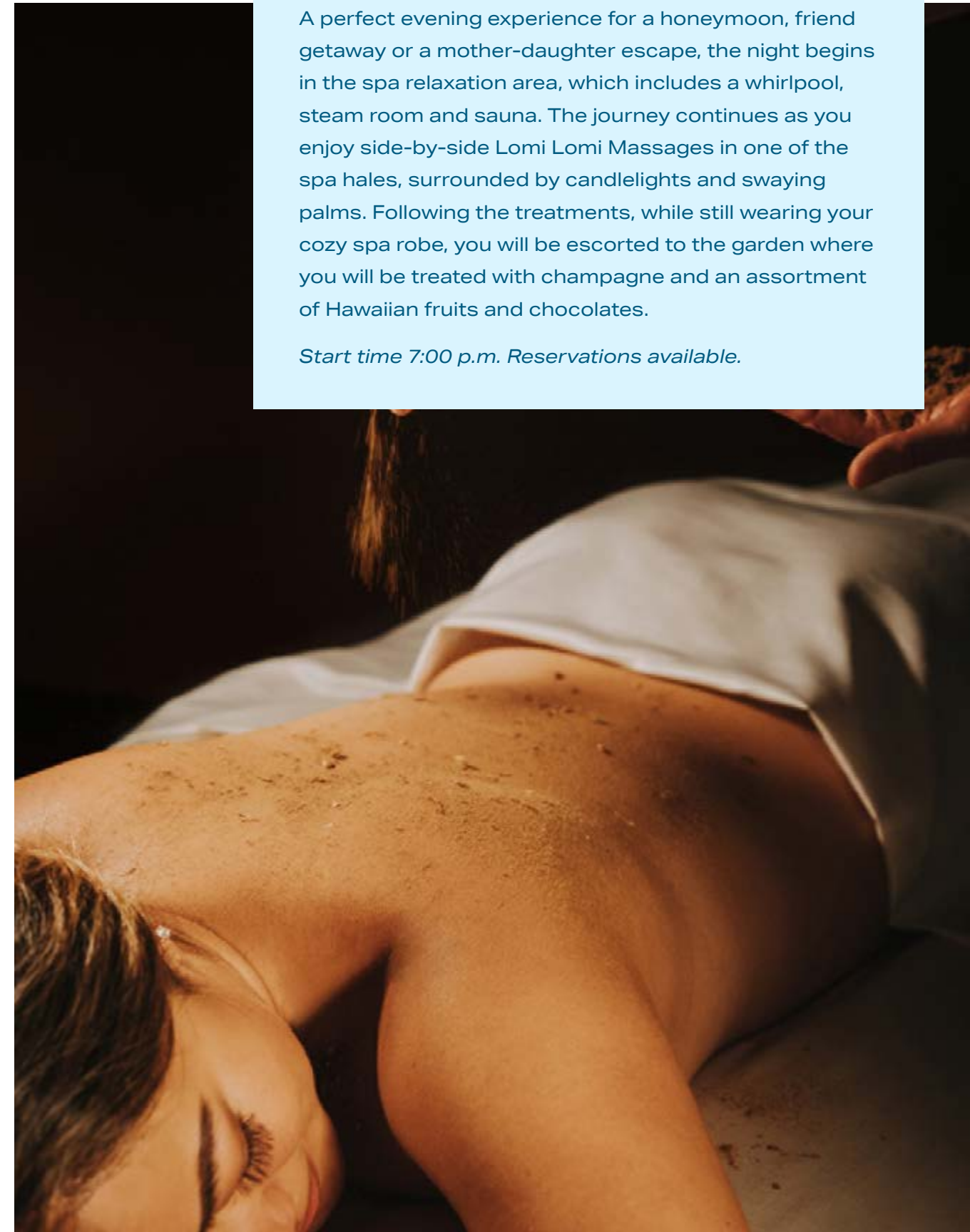


### MOONLIGHT MASSAGE EXPERIENCE
