




What dish should guests not miss?




Camper

For lessons, guests should arrive at the Ski Concierge 45 minutes before their meeting time at the base or 75 minutes before if meeting at the top of the mountain. Peak times are 8:00-10:00 am and 2:30-4:30 pm.

It all starts before you even arrive. Whether you're planning a family adventure, seeking private lessons, or considering an iconic heli-skiing trip, our pre-arrival concierge is there to tailor each detail to your style. Upon checkin, your journey begins at the resort's Whistler Blackcomb Mountain Store in the lower lobby. The staff is more than prepared—geared up with curated advice and on hand to fit you with the best equipment available, chosen for your skill level and adjusted for current conditions.

Once you're set, your skis and boots are whisked away to the Ski Concierge, located just steps from the Blackcomb gondola. Prefer to skip the walk? There's a quick shuttle that'll get you there in under three minutes. Every step of the way, the Ski Concierge is designed to remove the hassle, leaving you ready to embrace the mountain.

Arriving at the Ski Concierge is like joining a club of savvy insiders. Greeted by our valets, you'll find your boots warm, your locker ready, and your morning essentials waiting, with coffee and pastries laid out from 8:00 to 10:00 am. Our team isn't just here to help—they're also your source for Whistler's best-kept secrets. 

INSIDER TIPS FOR THE MOUNTAIN

histler Blackcomb, the largest ski resort in North America, offers a winter playground of epic proportions with two distinctive mountains, over 200 runs, and 8,171 acres of terrain. Whether you're seeking big mountain thrills, chasing fresh powder, or enjoying a scenic cruise between pine trees, each day on these mountains brings new adventure. Not sure where to begin? Here are some insider tips to make the most of your time on the slopes.

Getting Started On The Mountain

Access Whistler Blackcomb from three main points: Whistler Village, Whistler Creekside, and the Upper Village (for Blackcomb only). From these bases, four gondolas and two high-speed chair lifts transport skiers and snowboarders up, while a network of lifts distributes you across the expansive terrain.
